

**Devon County Council (Various Streets, Devon)
(Disabled Parking & Control of Waiting) (No.43) Amendment Order**

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce in

APPLEDORE: Revocation of Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time on a specified length of New Quay Street;

BARNSTAPLE: No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Sunflower Road;

BIDEFORD: Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 1 Hour No Return Within 1 Hour (Exemption for Residents Zone C Permit Holders) on a specified length of Victoria Grove; **Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on a specified length of Park Avenue; **Revocation of Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on a specified length of Victoria Grove;

EXETER: No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Blackboy Road Service Road; **Pay & Display (Tariff Exeter R1) (30 mins Free; 1 Hour £1.70; 2 Hours £3.10; 3 Hours £4.00; 4 Hours £4.80; Sat & Sun & Bank Hols Free) Mon-Fri excl Bank Hols 10am-5pm (Exemption for Residents Zone S7 Permit Holders)** on specified lengths of Rifford Road; **Residents Parking At Any Time Zone B** on a specified length of Cecil Road; **Residents Parking At Any Time Zone F** on a specified length of Blackboy Road Service Road; **Residents Parking At Any Time Zone G** on a specified length of Mount Pleasant Road; **Residents Parking At Any Time Zone L** on a specified length of Cedars Road; **Residents Parking At Any Time Zone M** on a specified length of Williams Avenue; **Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on specified lengths of Beacon Avenue, Bovemoors Lane, Browning Close, Chestnut Avenue, Commins Road, Isca Road, Lancelot Road and South View Terrace; **Revocation of Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on specified lengths of Blackboy Road Service Road, Cecil Road, Cedars Road, Hurst Avenue, Mount Pleasant Road, Rifford Road, Topsham Road Residential Access Road and Williams Avenue;

EXMOUTH: Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time on specified lengths of Burnside, New North Road, Nutbrook and Withycombe Village Road; **Revocation of No Waiting At Any Time** on specified lengths of Burnside;

IVYBRIDGE: Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time on a specified length of Clare Street;

KINGSWEAR: Residents Parking 10am-11am and 2pm-3pm on a specified length of Church Hill; **Revocation of Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on a specified length of Church Hill;

LYNMOUTH: Residents Parking At Any Time Zone A on a specified length of Tors Road; **Revocation of Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on a specified length of Tors Road;

NEWTON ABBOT: Pay & Display (Tariff Newton Abbot A) (20 mins £0.70, 40 mins £1.10, 1 Jour £1.90, Sun Free) Mon-Sat 9am-5pm Max Stay 1 Hour (Exemption for Residents Zone D Permit Holders) on a specified length of Elm Road; **Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on specified lengths of Albion Hill and Neville Road; **Revocation of Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on a specified length of Elm Road;

TOTNES: Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time on a specified length of Lower Collapark;

Residents, charity business occupier, supported living, school business, motorcycle, scooter and other vehicles band A permits (up to 100g/km) £35 annually, other vehicles bands B-K (101-225g/km) 1st permit £35, 2nd permit £55, 3rd permit £65; bands LM (over 225g/km) 1st permit £35, 2nd permit £65, extra permits £65; virtual visitor permit £30 per 200 hours for schemes not operating at all times/350 hours for schemes operating at all times - allocated in 1 hour sessions, physical daily visitor £30 for 30 (24 hour) permits, annual business permits: 1st £35, 2nd £75, 3rd £150; annual trade permit £45, short stay trade £60 for 20, daily trade permit £5, weekly trade £25; guest house/hotel visitors £30 for 20 permits; annual essential visitor permit £10, care worker permits are free.

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order is to implement regulatory disabled bays that have been requested throughout the County, to remove regulatory disabled bays no longer required and to adjust certain measurements in the Order so they correspond with existing on street road markings.

Specifically, the Order if made will preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
