

Devon County Council (Mid Devon HATOC) (Traffic Regulation) Tranche 3 Amendment Order

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce in

BAMPTON: No Waiting 9am-6pm on a specified length of South Molton Road; **Revocation of No Waiting 9am-6pm between 01 Jun and 30 Sep** on a specified length of South Molton Road;

BRADNINCH: No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Millway;

CULLOMPTON: No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Willand Road;

SAMPFORD PEVERELL: No Waiting At Any Time on specified lengths of Lower Town and Road From Moorend House To Huntland Hill Cross;

TIVERTON: No Waiting At Any Time on specified lengths of Lower Moor Way, Lowman Way and Old Road;

UFFCULME: No Waiting At Any Time on special length of The Square;

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.

Statement of Reasons

The restrictions are being proposed to resolve minor local issues that have been reported to the Council and considered as part of the Mid Devon Highways and Traffic Orders Committee local waiting restrictions programme. Specific details of what is proposed at each location can be found within the deposit documents.

The restrictions are proposed to avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and to preserve/improving the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
