

Proposals for West Golds Way, Bovey Road & Exeter Road, Newton Abbot

Devon County Council propose to make these under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for Newton Abbot

Devon County Council (West Golds Way, Newton Abbot) (No Waiting At Any Time) Amendment Order 6326 to introduce

- NO WAITING AT ANY TIME on specified lengths of West Golds Way. Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.

Devon County Council (Various Roads, Newton Abbot) (Restricted Road) Order 6327 to introduce

- RESTRICTED ROAD (30mph by virtue of streetlighting) on specified lengths of West Golds Way, Bovey Road and Exeter Road

Devon County Council (Bovey Road, Newton Abbot) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 6333 to introduce

- PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES on a specified length of Bovey Road

Statement of Reasons

The scheme involves constructing a new roundabout and bypass route to reduce the volume of traffic on an existing section of Jetty Marsh Road and the A382 Exeter Road, with the aim of reducing congestion and travel times on the existing roads, whilst providing better access for through traffic.

The restrictions are proposed to enable construction of the new roundabout and to manage parking and vehicle speeds on the new link road to ensure the safety of traffic using the new road and roundabout.

Specifically they are proposed for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property; and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
